TO THE STUDENT:

This booklet contains three essay questions. You may answer any or all of these essay questions. You can earn up to 12 points for each essay question.

In preparing your answers for the questions in this booklet you must take these steps:

1. Write your answer to Part A in this booklet. Part A is worth up to 4 points.
2. Write the first draft of Part B on the back of each essay page. The draft is worth 1 point.
3. Read carefully what you have written. Make any changes that will improve your first draft.
4. Write the final copy of each essay on the lined paper provided. Your final copy is worth up to 7 points.
5. Draw a line through any mistake you may make when you are writing your final copy. Make the correction and continue with your final copy. You do not need to bring a new final copy.
6. Read your final copy carefully. Check for correct spelling, capitalization, and punctuation. Make any corrections necessary.

Remember, you may answer any or all of the essay questions in this booklet. When you are done you must hand in this test booklet along with the final copies of each essay. Make sure your name is on this booklet and on each of your final copies.
